Carryon Baggage Rules: Flying to London

1. One standard size bag,
no bigger than
22in×17.5in×9.85in
2. One laptop computer
bag, briefcase or
equivalent. (The size is
not specified on this)



Carryon Baggage Rules: Flying Back to Houston

1. One industrial size bag, no bigger than
22in×17.5in×9.85in

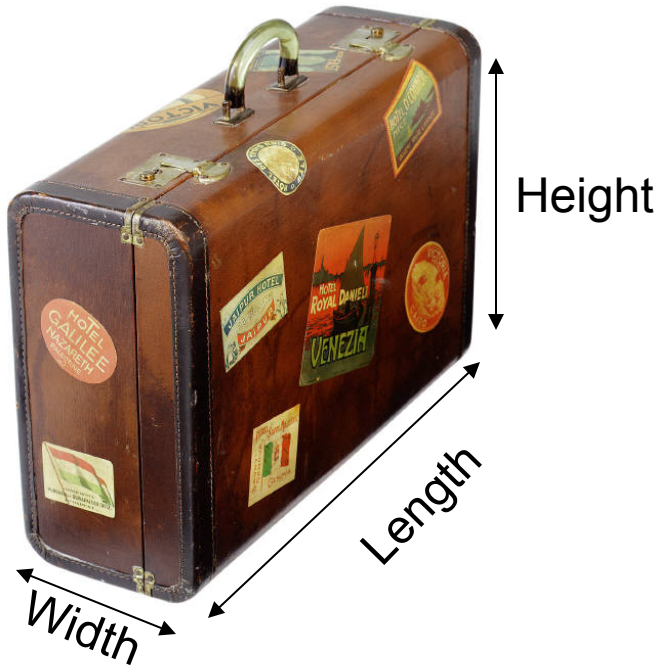
2. You are not allowed 2 carryon bags when you return to the US because your flights will connect in London!! Please plan your packing accordingly!



Liquid Restrictions

- ❑ Customers may take with them in their cabin bag (your carryon bag) limited quantities of liquids, gels and aerosols, including travel-size toiletries such as shampoo, suntan lotion, creams, toothpaste, hair gel and hair spray.
- ❑ Containers holding liquids must not exceed 3 ounces or 90mL.
- ❑ Liquid containers must be carried in a separate clear plastic zip-top bag that does not exceed 8inches×8inches or quart size. Items must fit in the bag comfortably and the bag must be **completely closed**.
- ❑ At the security search, the plastic bag must be removed from the cabin bag and x-ray screened separately.
- ❑ **MAKEUP IS INCLUDED IN THIS!!!** (i.e. foundation, mascara, etc.)
Please plan accordingly

Checked Baggage Rules



1. You are allowed to check one bag not exceeding 62 inches in total dimensions ($h+l+w$).
2. Your bag should weigh no more than 50 pounds (be sure to weigh it on the bathroom scale before you leave!)

Baggage Tips

Checked Baggage:

- ❑ Don't pack any valuables in your checked bag
- ❑ Label your bags with your name and destination address—get free baggage labels
- ❑ Also label each bag on the inside with your name and address
- ❑ Remove tags and labels left over from previous flights.
- ❑ Make sure there are no loose straps or other items hanging from the bag.

Hand Baggage:

- ❑ Do not take sharp objects in your hand baggage that will be confiscated at security
- ❑ Cigarette lighters are not permitted in hand baggage or about your person when traveling to/from the USA.
- ❑ Make sure you take medication, important documents, valuable items and cash in your cabin baggage.
