INSTRUCTIONS

Read all of the instructions carefully. The application process is very competitive so following directions is important.

Deadline Applications MUST be submitted online by 5pm on January 27, 2023 using this [link](#). The link to the application can also be found on our website on the same page used to access these instructions. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Process This is a two-part application process.

Part I: Applicant submits the required application by the deadline.

Part II: All applicants will be notified via email on February 2nd, 2023 whether or not they have been selected to proceed to the interview round.

High School Information If you attended a non-ranking school, you can put N/A for the rank and percentile fields. Please still include your class size. An SAT or ACT score is not required. We consider the student's highest, one-day test score. We **do not** combine the highest separate math and verbal scores from two different test dates (no super-scoring). We do not require separate verification documentation (i.e. high school transcript or College Board letter).
A TAMU Cumulative GPA of 3.7 or higher is required.

AP/Honors Page Please use the slide function to identify any AP or IB courses you took in high school. You should select N/A if you did not take the corresponding test. Please include any honors classes you have taken or intend to take next semester at Texas A&M. **Note:** It is not required to have taken or enrolled in honors courses at Texas A&M.

Unofficial Transcript Upload a copy of your PDF unofficial transcript from the Howdy Portal. Ensure that it shows your transfer hours (AP, Dual Credit, other college credit), spring courses, and fall classes with grades.

Essay

Write an essay on the following topic. Your essay must be typed, double-spaced, and no longer than 2 pages. Please save and upload as a PDF.

Annual reports provide a comprehensive overview of a company's financial condition and details concerning its performance. In addition, the report contains a letter to shareholders from the President or CEO. Investors use annual reports to help them make informed investment decisions.

Your application to Business Honors is similar to an annual report, and we will use it to help us make our "investment" decisions for the program. You have provided data about your academic record and shared the highlights of your involvement. The essay portion of the application serves as your letter to shareholders.

We have your academic successes, activities, and other involvement in front of us. What else do you want us to know about you? We are not looking for a specific answer to this question. Your Letter to Shareholders should contain information that, when combined with the other parts of the application, gives a more complete or in-depth picture of who you are.

Resume

Submit a **one-page** resume. Please save and upload as a PDF.

Interview

Applicants selected for an interview will be notified by email on February 2nd, 2023 with further instruction on the interview process. Dress for interviews is business casual. Additional details will be included in the email invitation to interview.

Applicants not selected for an interview will receive notification via email on February 2nd, 2023.
