

CIBS Ambassador Program Overview

The **Center for International Business Studies (CIBS) Ambassador** program is comprised of Mays Business School students that have participated in global study, intern and volunteer programs. These students assist CIBS in our globalizing mission by sharing their global experiences with current and prospective business students through outreach programs and marketing initiatives. CIBS Ambassadors enrich Mays students' international cultural awareness and global acumen and recruit students for the various programs provided by Mays Business School and Texas A&M University.

Primary and Continual Focus

- Support college efforts to recruit students for international opportunities by serving as guest speakers and providing international experience perspective
- Engage Mays student organizations through presentations and programming that highlight the benefits of pursuing global experiences
- Serve as a resource to Mays students and their families through office hours and at outreach events throughout the year

Qualifications

CIBS Ambassadors will represent diverse global experiences and perspectives during a two (2)-semester term (renewable at CIBS and member discretion) set to begin January 18, 2022. Interested applicants must:

- Have participated in an approved global program prior to the spring 2022 semester (*study, exchange, internship, volunteer or affiliate*)
- Be a current Mays Business School undergraduate or graduate student in good academic standing
- Commit to program for full academic-year term

Responsibilities

CIBS Ambassadors serve as representatives of CIBS and Mays Business School by sharing their global experiences and inspiring current and prospective Mays students to engage in cross-cultural learning experiences worldwide. Each ambassador will:

- Dedicate two (2) hours per week participating in CIBS office hours advise students and promote global opportunities and events through special projects and assignments and social media content creation
- Dedicate an additional five (5) hours per semester participating in outreach activities as follows:
 - Three (3) to four (4) hours per semester to speaking engagements or special events including, but not limited to: Mays student organizations presentations, informationals and pre-departure meetings; Go Global with Mays (September and March), Aggieland Saturday (February) and Education Abroad fairs
 - One (1) to two (2) hours per semester to Mays class presentations
- Attend a mandatory orientation during the beginning of the semester

CIBS Ambassador Scholarship

Ambassadors will receive a CIBS Ambassador Scholarship in the amount of \$500 for each participating semester. The scholarship will be awarded after successful completion of scholarship requirements at the end of each semester.
