

## CIBS Ambassador Program Overview

The Center for International Business Studies (CIBS) Ambassador Program is comprised of Mays Business School students that have participated in international study, intern, volunteer, and research programs. CIBS Ambassadors assist CIBS in our globalizing mission by sharing their global experiences with current and prospective business students through outreach programs and marketing initiatives. CIBS Ambassadors enrich Mays students' international cultural awareness and global acumen and recruit students for the various programs provided by Mays Business School and Texas A&M University.

### ► PRIMARY FOCUS

The primary goals of a CIBS Ambassador will be to:

- Support Mays' efforts to recruit students for global programs by serving as guest speakers to provide global experience perspectives
- Engage Mays student population through presentations and programming that highlight the benefits of pursuing global experiences
- Serve as a resource to Mays students through office hours and at outreach events throughout the year

### ► QUALIFICATIONS

CIBS Ambassadors will represent diverse global experiences and perspectives during a two (2) semester term set to begin on the first week of the fall semester.

Interested applicants must:

- Be a current Mays Business School student in good academic standing
- Have participated in an approved global program prior to the fall 2023 semester (*study, exchange, internship, volunteer, or research*)
- Commit to ambassador program for two (2) consecutive semesters

### ► RESPONSIBILITIES

CIBS Ambassadors serve as representatives of CIBS and Mays Business School by sharing their global experiences and inspiring current and prospective Mays students to engage in cross-cultural learning experiences worldwide.

CIBS Ambassadors will:

- Attend mandatory orientations before each semester and regular monthly meetings throughout the academic year
- Dedicate two (2) hours per week participating in CIBS drop-in hours activities as follows:
  - Peer advising students interested in pursuing a global program
  - Promoting global opportunities and programming
  - Assisting with general office administrative support and special projects and assignments
- Dedicate five (5) hours per semester participating in outreach activities as follows:
  - *Three (3) – Four (4) hours* of speaking engagements or special events including, but not limited to: Go Global with Mays, program informationals and pre-departure meetings; select Mays events, and Education Abroad fairs
  - *One (1) – Two (2)* Mays class presentations
- Facilitate general informationals and events in collaboration with fellow ambassadors throughout the semester

### ► BENEFITS

Ambassadors will receive a \$500 scholarship at the end of each participating semester. A CIBS program polo and nametag will also be provided.

### ► APPLICATION PROCESS

CIBS Ambassador Program applications for the 2023 – 2024 academic year are accepted via an online application until **Friday, March 10**. Interested applicants are encouraged to submit an application with the below supplemental materials at [tx.ag/CIBSambassadorapp](https://tx.ag/CIBSambassadorapp). Signing in to your [TAMU Office 365 account](#) using your NetID is required to access the application.

Application Supplemental Materials:

- **Resume** that includes:
  - Education, including all college or universities, attended
  - Global experiences to date (*i.e., study, work, travel, etc.*)
  - Modern language study (*specify language(s) and competency level*)
  - Honors, awards, extracurricular activities, and skills
- **Two (2)-Minute Video** of yourself addressing:
  - Self-introduction (*share your name, classification, major, and hometown*)
  - Your Mays global experience(s) to date or that are upcoming
  - How your global experience(s) impacted or will impact your academic and career goals
  - Advice you would give to Mays students interested in pursuing a global experience

Applications will be reviewed after the application deadline and applicants will be notified of their selection decision via email prior to the end of the spring 2023 semester.
