



APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE

Students seeking the entrepreneurship certificate should plan to complete the certificate requirements throughout their degree programs. Attempting to complete the certificate or saving certificate courses to be completed in just one or two semesters may result in the student being unable to complete certificate requirements due to high demand for entrepreneurship courses, as course availability cannot be guaranteed. All certificate programs are tracked through the Office of the Registrar and have to be added to the student's record through a request in the University Adjustment System (UAS). In order to add the certificates to the student's record, the following must be completed prior to the start of the student's graduating semester:
