

Requirements

- Current Undergraduate or graduate student of any major
- Must have at least 60 hours of coursework (U3, U4, or Graduate Students
- Must have a current cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher
- Must be in residence at Texas A&M University for the Spring 2025 semester
- Exceptions to these requirements may be made at the discretion of the Fellows Director. To request an exception, email <u>fellows@mays.tamu.edu</u>.

The Application Process

- 1. Application packet (details below) must be submitted electronically by **Friday**, **October 4th at** 11:59 pm
- 2. Application is available and must be submitted at https://mays.tamu.edu/undergraduate/high-impact-programs/business-fellows/
- 3. Interviews will be conducted for selected applicants
- 4. Fellows Group XLIII will be selected after all interviews have been conducted

Application Packet

A completed application packet includes one copy of each of the following. Please submit the resume, experiential log, and essay as separate PDF files.

1. Current Resume

- Limit to one page
- **DO NOT** put your name at the top; instead include the last four digits of your UIN
- **REMOVE** your name, address, and email address from the document
- Submit as a PDF file named "Resume.pdf"

2. Experiential Log

- The format for the log is provided here: http://mays.tamu.edu/special-programs/business-fellows/
- DO NOT put your name at the top; instead include the last four digits of your UIN
- Limit to four pages
- Use 12 pt. font
- Submit as a PDF file named "ExperientialLog.pdf"

3. Essay

- Expand on the following essay topic:
 - What is your most significant accomplishment in college and what factors allowed you to achieve it?
- Maximum two pages long
- submit as a PDF file named "Essay.pdf"

4. Professional Headshot

- Include a headshot of yourself in business professional attire
- Put the picture in a Word document and save as a PDF file
- Submit as a PDF file named "LastName.pdf"
